For April 2022, the Chief of Staff interviewed Past Commander Noble William “Bill” Zegley.

Noble William “Bill” Zegley was Commander of the Korein Legion of Honor in 2013. The year 2013 was an exciting year for all past Commanders. On 2 February 2013, the Legion of Honor celebrated the 55th year of our unit. More than 100 past members of the Legion of Honor were in attendance. The Special Guests were Noble Morris W. Sykes and Lady Suzette, and Korein Potentate Dan Zterkel, and Lady Andys. Noble Sykes was the Division Five Lieutenant Commander, International Association Legions of Honor from Kansas City. Commander William Zegley hosted the celebration. On 11 April, the Legion of Honor sponsored “The Celebration of the merger of Acacia No. 11 and Rocky Mountain Lodge No. 40” at the Shrine Club. In May, the Legion of Honor Posted the Colors for the Shrine Circus and on 8 June, the Legion Posted the Colors for the Wyoming Shrine Bowl. The Legion of Honor participated in all four Frontier Day Parades with the Go Carts (the LOH Riders) and the FEZ trailer. On 21 September, the Legion sponsored Ladies Night. November 1985. Following basic training, his first assignment was Kirtland AFB, New Mexico for five years. He subsequently accepted a European assignment to Rhein-Main Air Base, Germany in 1991 in time for deployment in C-130s to the Mideast in support of the Gulf War. Following three years in Rhein-Main, he was transferred as a Flight Engineer for C130s to Ramstein Air Base for an additional 7 years in Germany (yes, Noble Bill does speak German). 




Ill Sir Mark Shoemaker with the Potentate's gavel in Las Vegas.
