Editor's Ramblings Re: Shrine Bowl

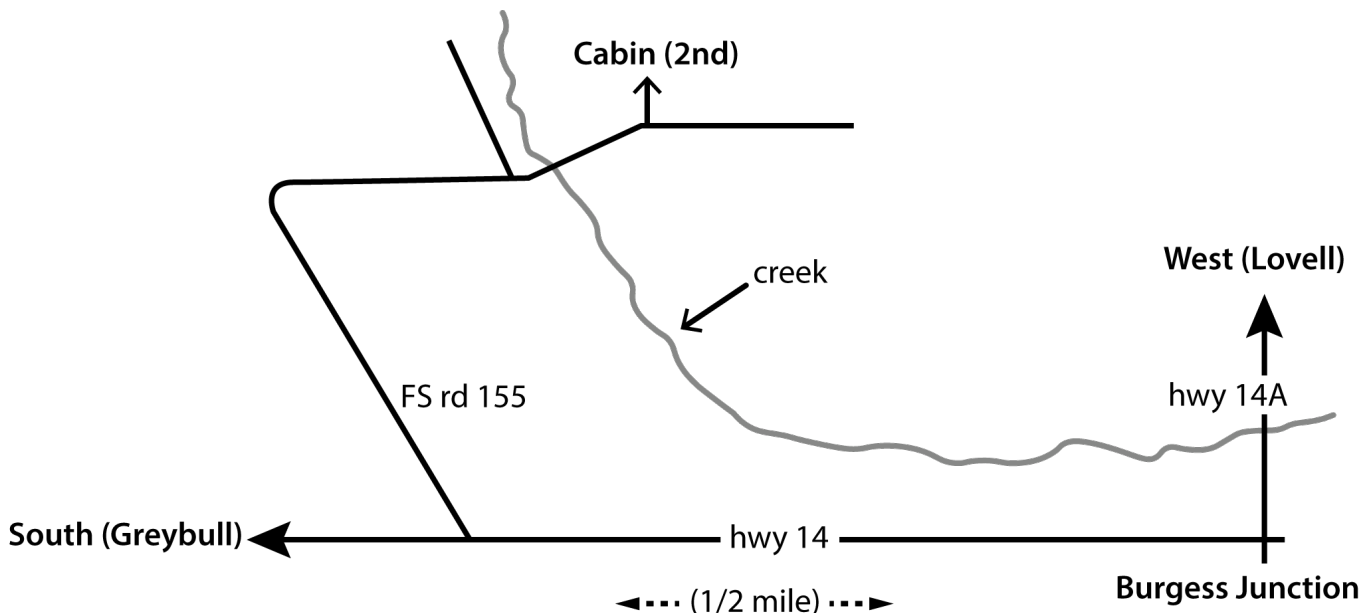

FREMONT COUNTY CLUB

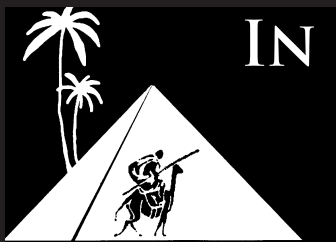
