PNSA gained two new Temples to our organization, Ben Ali of Sacramento, CA., and Asiya of San Mateo, CA. The vote of the delegates was unanimous. A new Temple in Lebanon, Lubnan Shriners, was given a charter making it the 200 th Temple worldwide for Shriners International.

I was honored to attend the Order of Eastern Star Grand Chapter of Wyoming Session along with Sharon Brantz, Queen of Sahida Temple #86 on August 9 th in Casper. It was the opening of their Grand Chapter Session. All of the Masonic Bodies in Wyoming were introduced and briefly spoke about their organization.

Kalif Temple held its summer picnic on Saturday, August 12 th at PP Bill Rathburn's cabin in the Big Horn mountains. Shriners from Jackson, Thermopolis, Greybull, Sundance and Gillette along with, Sheridan were in attendance. It was a nice cool day with plenty of great food.

Don't forget raffle tickets are available at the Oasis for the Side by Side and the Cast and Blast package. Also, remember October 21st is the Fall Ceremonial. Be sure and get those petitions filled out so we have some candidates.





We have reached our next goal of \$7000. Our totals are getting larger each year and we've been collecting since 2015, 136 loads averaging about \$50.



News from the Oasis


Greetings and salutations!
